Code Enforcement Officer: In the office the 1st Friday of every month.





Chickadee Plate Replacement

Starting May 1st no chickadee plates will be issued and anyone who currently has chickadee plates will be required to obtain new plates at time of renewal or when obtaining a new registration. Passenger (PC) class code registrants may choose from the Pine Tree or No Tree design at no additional costs. If you want to keep your current number, you can reserve it for a one-time fee of \$25.
