2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

I propose to construct a Temporary Permanent entrance to the Real Estate Account # property located on Tax Map, Lot, Sub Lot, on the NORTH SOUTH EAST WEST side of the road, at a point feet to the NORTH SOUTH EAST WEST from.

3. TERMS: Acceptance of this Application signifies the Applicant agrees to the following:

- i. The Permittee will provide, erect and maintain all necessary barricades, lights, warning signs and other devices, Flaggers and traffic control officers to safeguard traffic and construction laborers while the Work is in progress, and;
ii. The Permittee will notify Dig-Safe not less than 72 hours in advance of proposed Work (Toll-free 1-888-DIG-SAFE), and;
iii. The Permittee will notify the Town of Etna not less than 48 hours in advance of proposed start of Work, and;
iv. The Permittee acknowledges this permit does not authorize closing of the road or highway at any time during the time Work is in progress; meaning the road shall not be closed or obstructed to traffic at any time during the construction of the proposed road entrance, and;
v. The Permittee acknowledges and agrees where the access drive is located in or through a curb, curb and gutter, shoulder or sidewalk section, the Permittee will completely remove the existing curb, curb and gutter, or sidewalk section and replace same with a standard concrete or granite driveway return or return shoulder as was originally found, and;
vi. The Permittee will install all necessary erosion and sedimentation measures prior to the start of excavation and maintain same in functional order for the duration of all work or until a permanent vegetative cover is established on disturbed soil, and;
vii. The Permittee shall pay for all damages, fines and penalties for which the Permittee shall become liable, and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Etna, its inhabitants, employees and assigns, against all suits, claims, damages and proceedings of every kind arising out of the Work, maintenance and use of the subject access driveway, including those which arise from snow removal operations, and;
viii. The Permittee shall install the proposed entrance in accordance with the standards in effect for such entrances at the time of approval.

4. EXECUTION: Having read the above statements and the Standard Specifications for Opening or Entrance Construction and Restoration in Town Roads document for the Town of Etna, I/we agree to comply and signify this with my/our signature(s).
